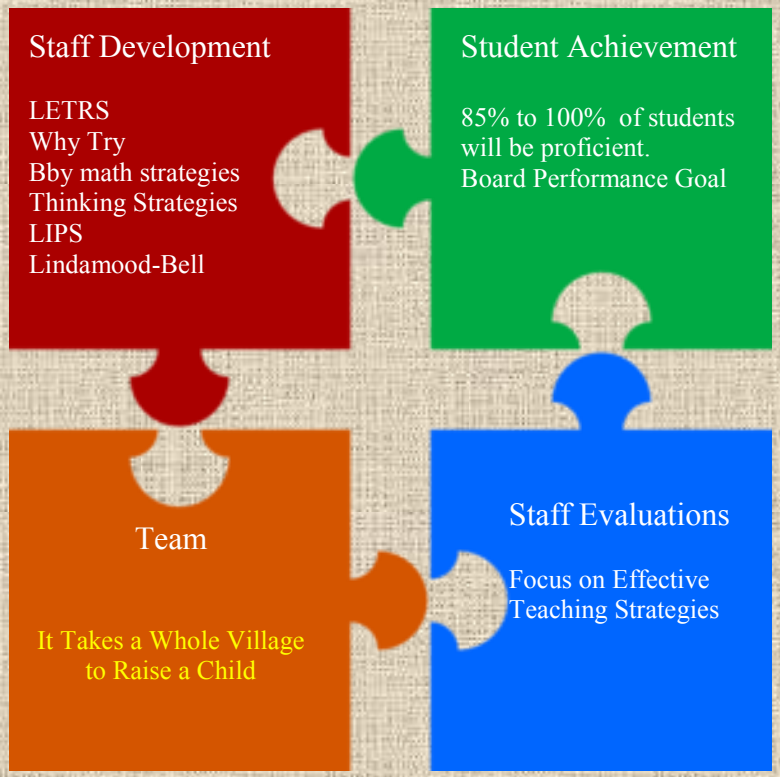
Our students will have the knowledge and skills to become ethical, responsible, productive citizens and life-long learners.

### 3 Big Ideas of a PLC

- Focus on Learning**  
 The fundamental purpose of the school is to ensure high levels of learning for all students. This focus on learning translates into four critical questions that drive the daily work of the school:
- What do we want students to learn? What should each student know and be able to do as a result of each unit, grade level, and/or course?
  - How will we know if they have learned? Are we monitoring each student's learning on a timely basis?
  - What will we do if they don't learn? What systematic process is in place to provide additional time and support for students who are experiencing difficulty?
  - What will we do if they already know it?
- Build a COLLABORATIVE CULTURE**
- No school can help all students achieve at high levels if teachers work in isolation.
  - Schools improve when teachers are given the time and support to work together to clarify essential student learning, develop common assessments for learning, analyze evidence of student learning, and use that evidence to learn from one another.
- Focus on Results**
- PLCs measure their effectiveness on the basis of results rather than intentions.
  - All programs, policies, and practices are continually assessed on the basis of their impact on student learning.
  - All staff members receive relevant and timely information on their effectiveness in achieving intended results.



### Overall Assessment of Learning

80-85% of students in grades 3-8 will demonstrate proficiency in areas measured by the State Assessment.

High School: 80%-85% of the students that participate in the ACT test will have a score of 17 or higher.

WCSD # 1 has a goal of 100% graduation rate!!

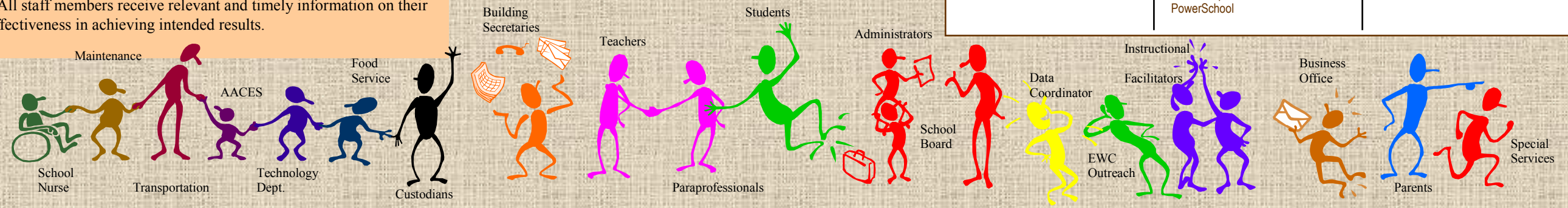
#### Diagnostic Tool Used:

100% of the students tested in MAP will show RIT (Rasch Unit) growth from fall to spring.

100% of the students that participate in DIBELS will show growth in their composite score from fall, winter, and spring testing windows.

80%-85% of the students will have a grade of C or better in respective classes (teacher judgment).
